The demand for sugar is extremely high but the supply has been low for quite some time now. This could be because of the high price of jute and also because some chief sugar growers have switched to high-priced jute. The price of sugar has soared because of the phenomena of the demand supply disparity. The price of sugar now equals that of jute.
